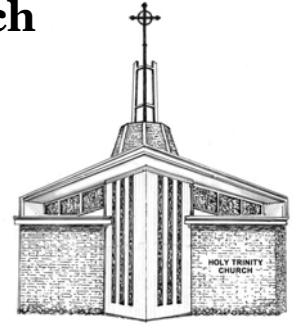

THE BIBLE AND THE SACRAMENTS



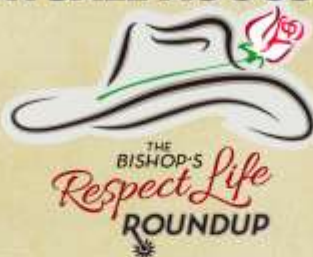
While we know a sacrament is an outward sign instituted by Christ to give grace, few of us know the biblical basis for each one.

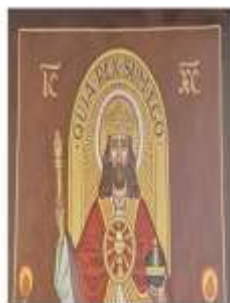
