

Rosary Rally

You are invited to join in a Rosary Walk for Life following the Noon daily Mass on Tuesday, January 27 at Holy Trinity Parish in Colorado Springs. Walkers will join pilgrims from various parishes who will silently pray the rosary as they walk from the church around the parish grounds stopping occasionally to pray other intercessions about .3 miles. If the weather is inclement, we will remain in the church and pray Stations Of The Cross For Life. We will be reinforced by special prayers offered at two diocesan Adoration Chapels. This combined prayer effort by adorers and rosary-walkers is part of a plan to engage more intently in the Spiritual Battle for the Sanctity of Life in Colorado and provide an umbrella of support for sidewalk advocates and prayer partners who witness near the Colorado Springs Planned Parenthood. Our prayers are indispensable in the battle for souls compromised by a culture that denies the sanctity and dignity of every precious life. A similar Rosary-Walk will occur monthly at different places throughout the Diocese, with supporting prayers from different adoration chapels.


Pope Leo XIV has chosen as the theme for the 2026 World Day of the Sick: *"The compassion of the Samaritan: loving by bearing the pain of the other."* This theme, released by the Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development, reminds us that love of neighbor is not abstract—it is lived through concrete gestures of closeness, especially toward those who suffer in isolation, poverty, or illness.

The Memorial of St. Blaise, a custom that began in the 16th century, although Blaise lived in the fourth century. He was the bishop of Sebaste in Armenia who, according to legend, saved the life of a boy who was choking on a fish bone

While the blessing may seem to be focused only on the throat, it has also been used to invoke God's power to cure any illness.
