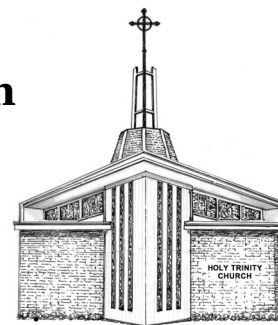

# PARTS OF A CATHOLIC CHURCH

WHAT THEY ARE AND WHY THEY MATTER



### 1. SANCTUARY (SACRED CORE)

The most sacred area where the celebration of the Eucharist takes place.

			
<b>AMBO</b> Where the Word of God is proclaimed.	<b>ALTAR</b> Place of sacrifice and celebration.	<b>TABERNACLE</b> Holds the Blessed Sacrament – Christ's real presence.	<b>PRIEST'S CHAIR (SEDES)</b> Seat of the priest who presides over the celebration.

### 2. PREPARATION AREA

**SACRISTY**  
Room for preparing the liturgy, vestments, and sacred vessels.

**CRESCENCE TABLE**  
Holds the sacred vessels and items used during Mass.

### 3. RECONCILIATION AREA

**CONFESSIONAL**  
A place for the Sacrament of Reconciliation, where sins are forgiven and grace is received.



### 4. NAVE (PEOPLE ZONE)

**NAVE**  
The main space where the faithful gather for prayer and worship.




**PEWS**  
Seating for the faithful to listen, pray and participate.

**CHOIR AREA**  
Leads the assembly in worship through music and song.

### 5. INITIATION AREA

**BAPTISMAL FONT**  
Where new life in Christ begins through the Sacrament of Baptism.

### 6. SYMBOLIC ELEMENTS (THROUGHOUT THE CHURCH)
