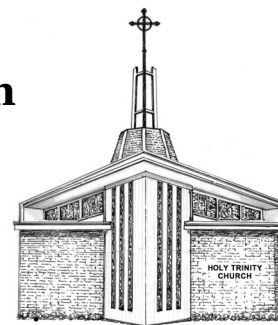


Marian House Needs Your Help


Hiring
