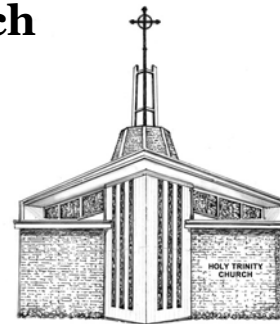

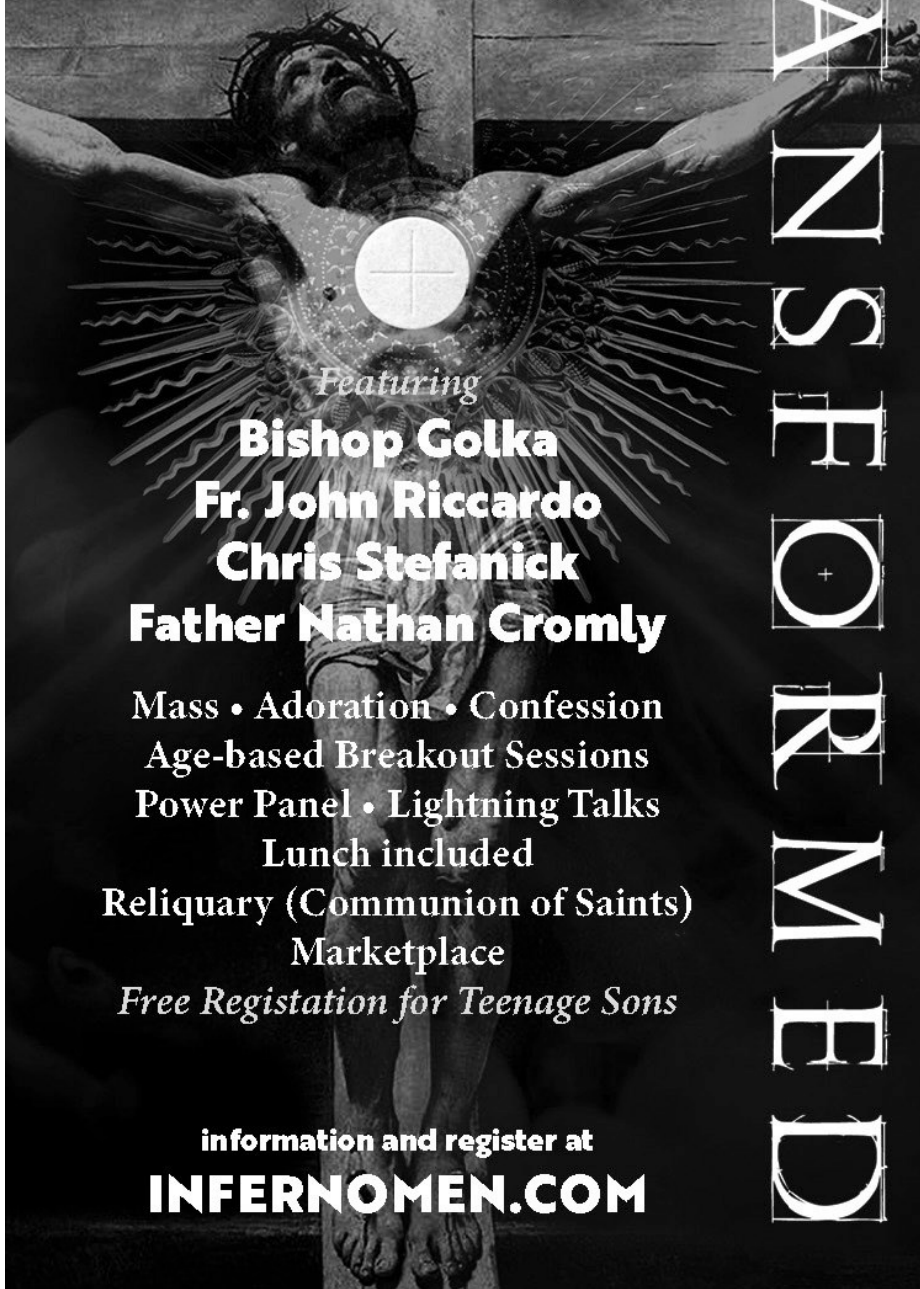

Holy Orders
(CCC 1601-1666)

Required State: A Baptized man who has been called for ordination by God; in the Western rite, with the exception of permanent deacons, the ordained must be celibate (CCC 1577-1580)

Frequency: Only once; separate ordination for Deacon, Priest, and Bishop (CCC 1582)

Scripture: Acts 6:5-6; 13:3;14:23; 20:28; Jn20:21-23; 1 Tim3:1; 4:14; 2 Tim1:6; Titus 1:5; Phil1:1

Effect: A special relationship to Christ to lead and serve the Church; indelible spiritual character imprinted on his soul (CCC 1581;1594)

Minister: Bishop (CCC1576)

Form: The Bishop's "specific consecratory prayer asking God for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit and his gifts proper to the ministry to which the candidate is being ordained" (CCC 1573)

Matter: Laying on of the Bishop's hands with the consecratory prayer (CCC 1538)
