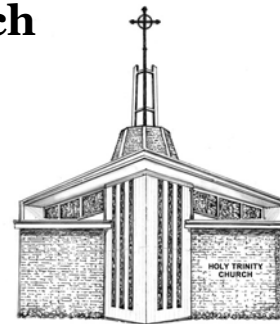

Anointing of the Sick, Extreme Unction, and Last Rites (CCC 1499-1535)

Required State: Seriously ill; at the point of death or before a serious operation or for the elderly whose frailty becomes more pronounced (CCC 1541f.)

Frequency: Repeatable; at the point of grave illnesses or before a serious operation (CCC 1514f.)

Scripture: Mk 6:13; Jn 20:23; Mt 16:18-19; 18:15-18; James 5:14-15

Effect: Sins forgiven; grace to face trial; spiritual preparation to die; and if God's will, physical healing (CCC 1520-1523)

Minister: the Priest (CCC 1566)

Form: Prayer of the Priest over the sick person for the grace of the Holy Spirit and the forgiveness of sins (CCC 1513, 1519)

Matter: Anointing with Holy Oil and Imposition of Hands (CCC 1513, 1519)
