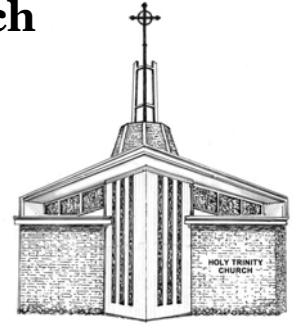

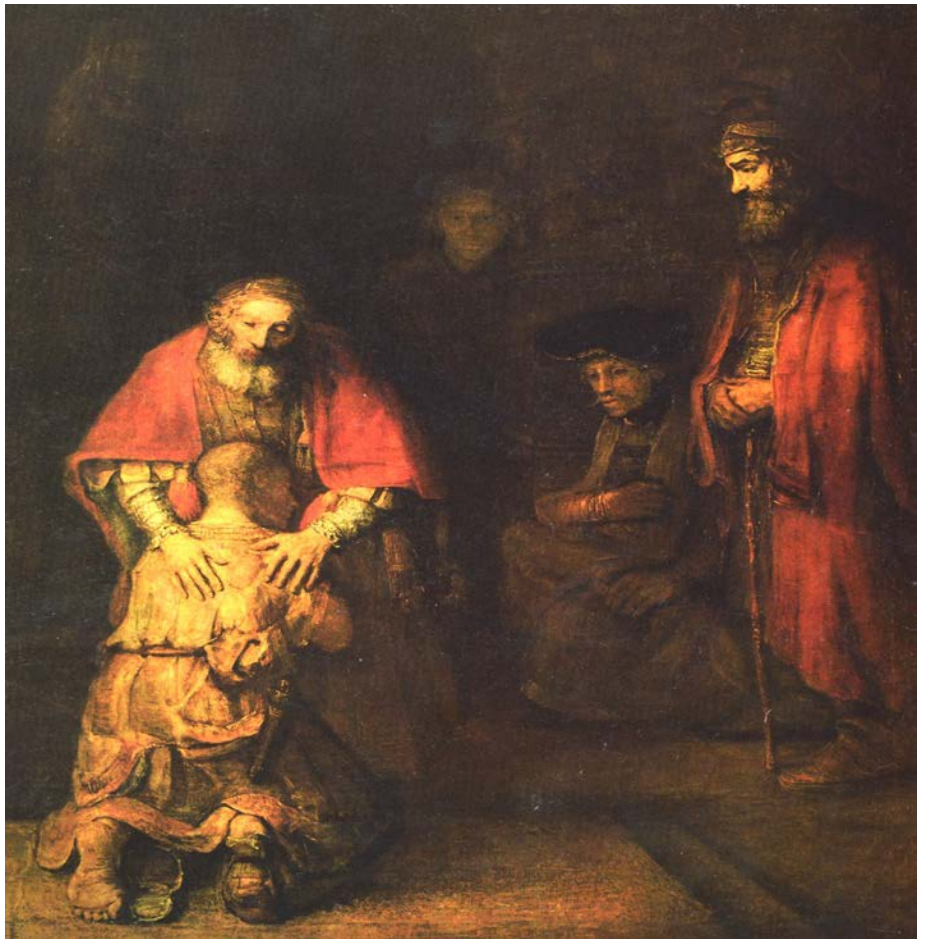

While we know a sacrament is an outward sign instituted by Christ to give grace, few of us know the biblical basis for each one.

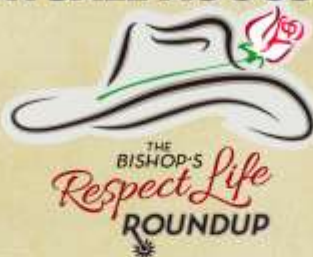

## Volunteers Needed

The Catholic bishops of Colorado support and encourage signature collection for these Colorado initiatives:
